PSGKA CODE OF CONDUCT

PSGKA is a family-friendly facility. Everyone entering the facility is expected to model good sportsmanship and to lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect and self-control. It is especially important for participants, parents and officials to encourage children and youth to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. Everyone is responsible for their words and actions while visiting the PSGKA facility and shall conform their behavior to the following code of conduct:

- 1. Good sportsmanship is expected at all times.
- 2. All behaviors will support the health, safety and well-being of all participants, parents, officials, staff and all other attendees.
- 3. There will be no excessive use of profanity.
- 4. Participants, parents, officials, staff and all other attendees will be treated with respect, regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability.
- 5. Participants and attendees will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any participant, parent, official, staff or any other attendee.
- 6. Participants and attendees will not initiate a fight or scuffle with any participant, parent, official, staff or any other attendee.
- 7. Feelings of frustration and anger are expected to be expressed in a respectful and calm manner.
- 8. All participants and attendees will abide by the 24-hour rule, which states: "No participant or parent, in a fit of frustration or anger over race incidents or officiating, will contact the officials or staff in any manner until 24 hours has passed."

PSGKA enforces a zero tolerance for what is deemed as disrespectful and inappropriate behavior. Anyone failing to conform to the above code of conduct while at the PSGKA facility in any capacity will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following, in any order or combination, as determined by a PSGKA official:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Suspension from the facility (length varying)
