- Call meeting to order
 - o Jeremy called meeting to order at 7:06 PM
- Reading of prior meeting minutes
 - o Doug motions to accept the minutes as read. Jen seconds. No nays.
- President's Report
 - o Not a lot has happened between last meeting and this one.
- Vice President's Report
 - o Nothing to report between last meeting and this one.
- Treasurer's Report
 - o Doug presented the balance sheet for April, accounts at a total of \$77,294.
 - o Checking is draining down pretty quickly from start of this year.
 - o Concerns about checking being down below 10k.
 - o Dave asked about if we have a report for last race as it pertains to revenue/expenses.
 - o Doug guesses we didn't get anywhere near current expenses for this year.
 - o Race 1+2 took in about 5k. Trophies was about 1180. NKA fees was 461.

- New Business

- Tracking Grinding
 - Mark Miller from Delmar Concrete Cutting and Grinding, he has the proper tools.
 - We have at least 3-4 inches of asphalt in most places. Maybe a few places are closer to 3 inches.
 - Need to get an estimate for a half or full day of grinding. Get a team of people to come out with various straight edges, use paint to pick the high spots to be ground down.
 - Response from Mark. Wants two banners on track, logo on the website, announcements at the races. Likely not free, but probably inexpensive.
 - Mark will contact his office to coordinate on a time.
 - This means we likely need to be painting the grinding spots this weekend.
- Apparel/Merch
 - Jen: When do we want to do this with the tight finances?
 - Brian points out we either should do it before Super Cup to get all the sales for that, or after Super Cup
 - Jen suggests getting stickers with new logo for the 3rd race. Then apparel before race 4.
 - Tobin: They're making stuff for the vintage event, with the new logo. New logo should look good on apparel.
 - Various vintage guys should be coming back around soon.
 - Jen will email Michael Tobin about sizes, volumes, hats, etc. tomorrow
- Trophies
 - 1st place gets a trophy, 2nd/3rd get medallions. Should reduce the overall trophy cost by a lot. Jen working on getting cost for this.
 - We have a lot of 3rd places at the moment.
 - Trophies are averaging somewhere around 20-30 dollars each.
 - Jen mentioned removing the year.
- Photographer
 - Is the person we had at the first races coming back? Seems we aren't sure. He was under 18, but his parents came with him.
 - We can probably get an NKA waiver for the kid, if we have a notarized form. Maybe the kid could drive himself? Jer thinks the dad enjoyed the day.
 - Name is Aidan Ma.
 - Doug suggests we have one point of contact with him. To avoid confusion. Jer volunteered to do it.
- PA System

- Doug motions that we buy a microphone that works with our various input needs, and move forward with a second set of the system Brian has come up with for wireless FM transmission/receiving.
